### Ski/Board/Tube with common sense



MountainView encompasses many acres of both gentle and steep terrain. Skiing, boarding, and tubing are exciting, challenging participant sports that often present dangers and inherent risks, including but not limited to trees, uneven terrain, bare and/or icy spots, natural and man-made objects, snow-making vehicles, snowmaking equipment, and other skiers. If you cannot accept these inherent risks, we ask that you do not ski/board/tube at MountainView.

### Observe Trail Rules

1. Ski/board under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid other skiers/boarders or objects.
2. When skiing/boarding downhill or overtaking another skier, you must avoid the skier below you.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4. When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to other skiers.
5. All skiers and boarders shall wear retention straps or other devices to help prevent runaway skis and boards.
6. You shall keep off closed trails and posted areas and observe all posted signs.

Okay, so you don't like that "getting cold" stuff, then bring a book and pull up a bench. The lodge features an enormous wood stove, and lots to choose from at the snack bar.

### SnoKids

MountainView specializes in teaching kids to ski and board! SnoKids is a six week program with sessions held Saturday morning, Saturday afternoon, Sunday morning and Sunday afternoon. Advance registration is required. The sessions will start Jan. 6 2007. Cost for 6 lessons and lift ticket is \$105.00. If ski rentals are needed, add \$30.00 for a total of \$135.00. Snowboard rentals would be an additional \$60.00 for a total of \$165.00. SnoKids passes are accepted for the remainder of the season on the scheduled morning or afternoon of your lessons once the program has been completed. Rentals are not included in this offer. Minimum age for skiers is 5 years, snowboarders is 7 years.

MountainView believes skiing is for all ages so we offer the SnoParents program. The same six week program as the SnoKids; you also can have 1 hour of instruction and lift ticket for \$115.00. Good news- you won't be in the same class with your child, so they won't have to see those first few missteps! If you already know how to ski, but would just like to polish those skills, MountainView has Level 2 & 3 instructors available to help you improve your form. Please note, lesson schedules may be altered by the Ski School, Ski Area, or Group Advisor when weather necessitates a change.
